

Do You Need an Electrical Inspection?

This question seems to come up many times during the year. The fact of the matter is that since the 1950's Minnesota law has required and enforced electrical inspections statewide. Many people don't realize this until they try to sell or refinance their property. Generally, Minnesota law requires all electrical work to be performed by licensed, bonded and insured electrical contractors and their employees. Homeowners with strict limitations are exempt from licensing, but not from inspection. A separate request for electrical inspection form with the required fees must be submitted to the Department at or before the commencement of any electrical installation. If you have had electrical circuits added, extended or altered you should have also had a visit from your local electrical inspector.
